Note A - The report does not breakdown tax on rental income in each province by order of government. For this table, we have assumed the same ratio applies in each province as applies on average nation-wide. Any differences would be very small.

Note B - The report estimates the income tax paid on rental income. The report does not estimate the income taxes paid on capital gains, so that the actual provincial, federal and grand total of taxes generated by rental housing is even larger, and the actual provincial and federal shares of total government tax revenue are both larger.
